Beyond the frame

Athens-based Canadian photographer/fine artist Chris Stewart adds a new dimension to photography

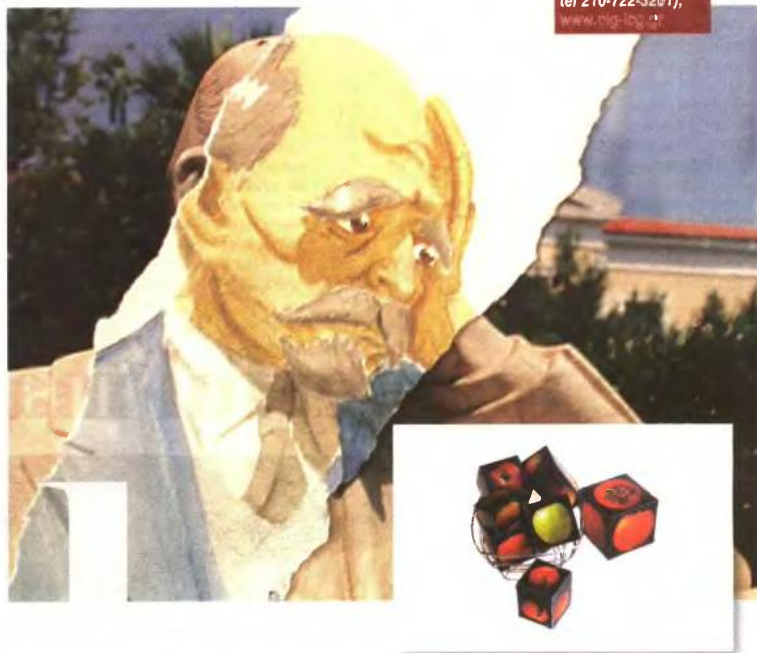
TAKING snapshots to another level, the *Senses* show has been a long time coming for recent Athens resident Chris Stewart. "I would often see people looking at my photographs, going, 'Well, all you did was go up to this flower and click!'," says Stewart about his move from conventional imagery to the more adventurous mixed-media realm. "Any professional will tell you there's a lot more to it than that, so I decided to take photography out of this simplicity and go from a rectangle that hangs on the wall to something a lot more unexpected!"

He started as a studio animator in Toronto, but a series of subsequent moves owing to his wife's professional obligations gave Stewart the push he'd always needed to take his art on the road. "It had been in the back of my mind for a while and relocating was a good opportunity to explore new paths," he notes.

While still working as an animator, Stewart had started up another pet project, called www.candycritic.org, where he reviewed

candy from around the world. This turned out to be a runaway online success and yet another reason to hone his visual skills, as photographing the treats he sampled was mandatory. That and the still photography required to add texture in 3D animation helped him reinvent himself as a photographer and later on as a fine artist. Moving away from snapshots of reality meant his work didn't just taunt people's vision but prompted all five senses - including taste - which lent their name to his first Athens-based solo show. "It was the candy photography - people always told me they'd get hungry just looking at the work!" You can expect to see painting interventions on traditional photographs, quirky photo collages and some yummy candy-inspired art.

Never forgetting it was his professional training that eventually led him to fine art, Stewart had been looking for a way to give something back and the Canadian Institute in Greece finally provided the means. Part of the proceeds from the *Senses* show will go towards the Institute's library in recognition of the role it has played in culture and education. As for the Candy Critic site, you'll be pleased to know it now features a vast array of local icecream and candy Stewart has sampled during his Athens stay, although he keeps his candy intake to a bare minimum since his continuing success means his future will never be entirely sugar-free.
